Background

The Department of Human Services' (DHS) budget for State Fiscal Year 2019 is approximately **\$1.9 billion**.

Most of the services DHS provides are through contracts with private service providers, non-profits, colleges or other state agencies.

DHS processes over **4,000** contracts annually.

The current process, which is largely manual, involves a lot of paper, walking, telephonic and email follow up.



Project Goals

- Automate the DHS contracting process
- Increase transparency through real time tracking
- Enhance process compliance through the gathering and reporting of data
- Reduce contract turn around time
- Improve work management with dashboards, work queues, alerts and reminders for key tasks, dates and deadlines

What is eCAT?



- eCAT is the DHS contract life-cycle management system.
- eCAT centralizes and automates DHS processes for requesting, developing, approving, executing and tracking contracts as well as reporting data.



eCAT Features


- Centralized contracting process
- A secure database for all contract data
- Customizable user dashboards, contract workflows, approval routing, automatic notifications and e-signature
- Data extraction for reports and analysis
- Full featured searching using any number of fields
- Stores pending contracts and executed contracts
- System distribution of contracts to programs and contractors




eCAT Benefits

- Centralizes contract submission, creation and execution
- Fully automates the contracting process
- Cloud-based system that can be accessed from virtually anywhere there is an internet connection
- Increases efficiency, transparency and accountability
- Decreases processing times, submission errors and paper usage
- Creates ability to track data through customized reports

Tracking






Reporting
