GA LIHEAP

Program Purpose

- Assist low income households, particularly those with the lowest incomes who use a high proportion of household income for home energy, meet their immediate home energy needs
- Assist low-income households with a primary energy source
- Payments issued to home energy providers on behalf of households
- One time payment averaging \$345



GA LIHEAP OVERVIEW

- Funded by an annual federal block grant
- Operates on a Federal Fiscal Year
- Program Opens Nov. 1 for Homebound/Elderly households (Georgia's priority group)
- December 1- General population households are served as funding permits
- Benefits provided on a first come/first served basis

GA LIHEAP ELIGIBILITY

- Means Based Program
- 60% of State Median Income (\$40,366 family of 4)
- Citizenship/Social Security Number
- Household Size
- Responsible for paying home energy obligation



GA LIHEAP ELIGIBILITY

- Combination Intake System
 - Appointment
 - Walk-in
- Most Crisis Situations Walk-In
- 80% households approved within 11 days



GA LIHEAP ADMINISTRATION

- Contract via 19 Local Community Action Agencies
- Allocations based 100% on local county poverty population
- Average 9% funding for program administration
- 98% direct payment to energy providers
