DIVISION OF FAMILY AND CHILDREN SERVICES (DFCS)

DFCS – Education – EPAC Referrals

- Increase the percentage of Educational Programming and Assessment Consultation (EPAC) referrals for youth in foster care from 46% to 90% by June 30, 2019
- Baseline: 46%
- SFY17 Goal: 46%
- SFY18 Goal: 68%
- End of SFY17: 55%
- YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 74%



DFCS – Education – Foster Care HS Graduation

- Increase the percentage of youth in foster care who successfully graduate from high school from 17% to 75% by June 30, 2019
- Baseline: 8%
- SFY17 Goal: 17%
- SFY18 Goal: 46%
- End of SFY17: 25%

DIVISION OF AGING SERVICES (DAS)

DAS – Health – Congregate Sites

- Increase the number of seniors served through congregate sites by 9% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 13,744 SFY17 Goal: 13,744 End of SFY17: 15,271
- SFY18 Goal: 14,156 YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 11,110



DAS – Health – Home Delivered Meals

- Increase the number of seniors served through home delivered meals by 9% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 12,445 SFY17 Goal: 12,445 End of SFY17: 12,666
- SFY18 Goal: 12,818 YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 9,560

DFCS – Health – FMS Promptness

- Improve the Family Medicaid Standard (FMS) of promptness to 92% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 85% SFY17 Goal: 85% End of SFY17: 91.28%
- SFY18 Goal: 90% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 76.70%

DFCS – Health – Healthcare for Youth

- Increase the percentage of youth in foster care receiving Medicaid or health Insurance, within six months of their 18th birthday, from 45% to 85% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 45% SFY17 Goal: 45% End of SFY17: 94%
- SFY18 Goal: 60% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 95%



DFCS – Health – SNAP Nutrition Education

- Increase the number of SNAP Nutrition Education participants that receive information regarding healthy and nutritious food choices for low income families from 49,184 to 81,058 (65%) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 49,184 SFY17 Goal: 53,686 End of SFY17: 114,803
- SFY18 Goal: 67,504 YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 21,687



DFCS – Health – Wellness Screenings

- Increase the percentage of initial wellness screenings for youth in foster care from 16.9% to 75% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 16.90% SFY17 Goal: 16.90% End of SFY17: 20.89%
- SFY18 Goal: 45.95% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 23.90%

DIVISION OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES (DCSS)

DCSS – Safety – Arrears Paid

- Increase the percentage of current arrears paid by 4.5% by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 65.7% FFY17 Goal: 65.7% End of FFY17: 64.85%
- FFY18 Goal: 66.7%



DCSS – Safety – Current Support Paid

- Increase the percentage of current support paid by 4.5% by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 61.3% FFY17 Goal: 61.3% End of FFY17: 60.29%
- FFY18 Goal: 62.3%



DCSS – Safety – Establish Paternity

- Increase the number of paternitys established by 4.5% by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 90.2% FFY17 Goal: 91.2% End of FFY17: 97.18%
- FFY18 Goal: 92.7%

OHR - Responsible & Efficient Government – DAS Social Service Specialist Turnover

- Maintain the DAS Social Service Specialist annualized turnover rates of 12.65%.
- Baseline: 12.65% SFY17 Goal: 12.65% End of SFY17: 12.29%
- SFY18 Goal: 12.65% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 1.1%



OHR - Responsible & Efficient Government - DCSS Agents Turnover

- Decrease the DCSS Agents annualized turnover rates 15.81% to 9% (6.81% reduction) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 15.81% SFY17 Goal: 15.81% End of SFY17: 19.87%
- SFY18 Goal: 12% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 5.4%



OHR - Responsible & Efficient Government – DFCS Child Welfare Case Managers Turnover

- Decrease the DFCS – Child Welfare Case Management staff annualized turnover rates from 36% to 18% (18% reduction) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 36% SFY17 Goal: 30% End of SFY17: 29.14%
- SFY18 Goal: 26% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 5.7%

OHR - Responsible & Efficient Government – DFCS OFI Case Managers Turnover

- Decrease the DFCS – OFI Case Management staff annualized rates from 17% to 11% (6% reduction) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 17% SFY17 Goal: 15% End of SFY17: 19.9%
- SFY18 Goal: 13% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 5.1%



OHR - Responsible & Efficient Government - DHS Full Time Employees Turnover

- Maintain the DHS Full-Time staff annualized turnover rates of 20.68%.
- Baseline: 20.68% SFY17 Goal: 20.68% End of SFY17: 19.93%
- SFY18 Goal: 20.68% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 4.6%



OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS AND OUTREACH (OLAO)

OLAO - Responsible & Efficient Government - Constituent Services

- Increase the resolution rate of constituent legislative inquiries, within five days of receiving the inquiries, from 85% to 95% (10%) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 85% SFY17 Goal: 85% End of SFY17: 87.99%
- SFY18 Goal: 90% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 89.69%

OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACTS (OPC)

OPC - Responsible & Efficient Government - Contract Execution Cycle

- Decrease the average number of days for DHS Standard Human Services contracts within the OPC execution cycle from 42 days to 31 days by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 42 Days
- SFY17 Goal: 42 Days
- End of SFY17: 35 Days
- SFY18 Goal: 36 Days
- YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 26 Days



OPC - Responsible & Efficient Government - Non-Standard Contract Execution Cycle

- Decrease the average number of days for DHS Non-Standard contracts within the OPC execution cycle from 30 days to 15 days by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 30 Days
- SFY18 Goal: 22 Days
- YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 20 Days

DAS – Safety – At-Risk Adult Crime Tactics (ACT) Training

- Increase the number of At-Risk Adult Crime Tactics (ACT) certified specialists from 250 to 300 (20%) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 250 SFY17 Goal: 265 End of SFY17: 267
- SFY18 Goal: 285 YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 87



DAS – Safety – Adult Protection Services Client Visits

- Increase the percentage of initial Adult Protection Services (APS) client visits that occur within 10 calendar days of intake from 90% to 95% (5%) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 90% SFY17 Goal: 93% End of SFY17: 94.69%
- SFY18 Goal: 94% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 95.13%



DAS – Safety – Transition from Nursing Facilities

- Increase the number of individuals that transition from nursing facilities back into the community from 125 to 137 (9%) by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 125 SFY17 Goal: 129 End of SFY17: 218
- SFY18 Goal: 133 YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 28

DCSS - Safety - Noncustodial Parent PAC Participant Collection

- Increase collections from noncustodial parents that participate in the Parental Accountability Courts (PAC) program from \$547,489 to \$1,166,390 by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: \$547,489 FFY17 Goal: \$737,489 End of FFY17: \$1,436,013
• FFY18 Goal: \$999,763

DCSS - Safety - Noncustodial Parent PAC Participants

- Increase the average number of noncustodial parents that participate in the Parental Accountability Courts program from 506 to 1078 by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 506 FFY17 Goal: 682 End of FFY17: 1,224
• FFY18 Goal: 924

DCSS – Safety – Parental Accountability Courts

- Increase the number of Parental Accountability Courts from 22 to 49 by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 22 FFY17 Goal: 32 End of FFY17: 32
• FFY18 Goal: 42

DFCS - Safety - Case Planning Participation

- Increase family and individual participation in Child Welfare case planning from 42% to 95% by September 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 42% SFY17 Goal: 59.7% End of SFY17: 42%
- SFY18 Goal: 77.3% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 46%



DFCS - Safety - Finalized Adoptions

- Increase the percentage of children in foster care with adoptions that finalize (within 24 months of entering care) from 28% to 52% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 28% SFY17 Goal: 28% End of SFY17: 21%
- SFY18 Goal: 40% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 30.5%



DFCS - Safety - Monthly Parent Visits - Birth Fathers

- Increase the percentage of monthly parent visits in Child Protective Services and foster care from 80% to 95% for birth fathers by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 80% SFY17 Goal: 80% End of SFY17: 87.02%
- SFY18 Goal: 87.5% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 88.3%

DFCS - Safety - Monthly Parent Visits - Birth Mothers

- Increase the percentage of monthly parent visits in child protective services and foster care from 87% to 95% for birth mothers and by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 87% SFY17 Goal: 87% End of SFY17: 90.47%
- SFY18 Goal: 91% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 91.7%



DFCS - Safety - Relative Placement in Foster Care

- Increase the percentage of relative placement for children in foster care from 25.6% to 50% by June 30, 2019.
- Baseline: 25.6% SFY17 Goal: 27.4% End of SFY17: 29%
- SFY18 Goal: 38.7% YTD Total as of SFY18 – 1st Qtr.: 32%
