# Rule Change Procedure

1. Board Considers Motion to Publish Proposed Rule
2. 30-Day Public Comment Period
3. Public Hearing
4. Motion for Final Adoption of Proposed Rule
5. Send Final Rule to Secretary of State

# Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Appeals

- Purpose: Each Georgian who submits an application for TANF benefits has the right to appeal an eligibility decision. The appeal is heard and a final decision is made by the Office of State Administrative Hearings. This proposal aligns this rule with current Georgia law that was modified in 2018.

# Recommended Revision to TANF Rule

HB 790 amended O.C.G.A. §§ 50-13-41 and the legislation became effective  
May 8, 2018
