>>> Pre-Application CCSP Provider Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Provider agency must have the legal right to conduct business in the State of Georgia (i.e., current business license or other proof of legal authorization).
- 2. Must have current, non-restrictive license, if required by CCSP service, issued by the Georgia Department of Community Health, Healthcare Facility Regulation Division (HFR).
- 3. Must maintain business premises in Georgia that are appropriate to conduct CCSP business.
- 4. Must have been in business in the service for which application is being made <u>a minimum of 12</u> consecutive months prior to making application.
- 5. Must attend CCSP Provider Pre-Enrollment and New Provider Training prior to enrollment in the CCSP. Participation is by DAS CCSP invitation only.
- 6. Must mail to CCSP the completed *Department of Community Health Medicaid Provider Enrollment Application* and the *CCSP Medicaid Provider Enrollment Application*. Both CCSP and DCH must approve enrollment of a provider agency application.
- 7. If applicable, provider agency must have a satisfactory site visit.

NOTE: CCSP does not guarantee client referrals. CCSP clients always have choice of providers.
